



The average foster child moves seven times before reaching adulthood. Often, these moves are abrupt, leaving them with very few belongings and deepening the sense of instability and confusion they already face.

In 2017, we founded *For Families Like Us*, a nonprofit organization dedicated to supporting foster families. We established a special shop where foster families can access free clothing, shoes, and supplies for infants, children, and teens in foster care, kinship care, or other approved placements, as well as for children adopted from foster care.

As former foster parents and a former foster child ourselves, we deeply understand the unique challenges faced by children in the foster and kinship systems. Our mission is simple yet impactful: to help these children feel normal and valued during times of transition.

This vital work is made possible by the generosity of our volunteers and donors, who give their time, talents, and resources to advance our mission. Today, we are seeking additional support in the form of a donated space to house our clothing closet.

We are in need of approximately 1,000 square feet to provide free clothing to children in foster and kinship care. While our long-term goal is to purchase a permanent space, we are currently seeking a rent-free location on a month-to-month basis.
